**Here's all you need to know.**

### Wheelchair Basketball FAQ

#### Competition Structure

- ✚ Three on three - round robin.

#### Teams Composition

- ✚ Max 5 players.
- ✚ Team of 5 players may have up to 2 players without disability.
- ✚ Team of 3 players may have 1 player without disability.
- ✚ Each team will require a Team Captain to be the main contact person for ParaQuad and team members to liaise with.

#### Games Format

- ✚ Two ten-minute halves, five-minute half time, five minute warm up.

#### Uniform

- ✚ Each team will need to nominate a team colour and provide their own uniform in the nominated colour.

#### **Registration** (Tasmanian Masters Games & ParaQuad Tas Registration)

**IMPORTANT:** It is a requirement that teams register through the Tasmanian Masters Games portal by following this link. **Add Link TBA** We recommend that the Team Captain completes registration in the first instance. Instructions on how to do this are attached.

**NOTE:** **Tasmanian Masters Games (TMG) charge a \$69 registration fee per competitor** to be paid at the time of registering which includes event medals, show bag with your ID card & lanyard, official embroidered Games Cap, Hartz water, a water bottle, local business vouchers and a sample of Anvers Confectionary premium chocolate. Plus, free entry into the Official Welcome Event on Saturday 5th October 2024.

**ParaQuad Tasmania are charging a \$25 fee per competitor to cover court hire etc. Total \$94** to be paid per individual at registration through TMG portal.

### **Code of Conduct**

As a member of ParaQuad Tas, grant recipients must meet the following requirements regarding their conduct during any activity held by, or under the auspice of ParaQuad Tas.

1. Comply with the constitution of ParaQuad Tas, its policies and standards.
2. Compete, according to the rules and regulations as governed by ParaQuad Tas. / Physical disABILITY Sports Tasmania including National and International guidelines pertaining to the sport in which they are competing.
3. Not use their involvement with ParaQuad Tas. / Physical disABILITY Sports Tasmania to promote their own beliefs, behaviors or practices where these are inconsistent with those of ParaQuad Tas. / Physical disABILITY Sports Tasmania.
4. Refrain from any form of abuse harassment or discrimination towards others.
5. Treat people involved in their sport with courtesy, respect and have proper regard for their rights and obligations and, respect the spirit of fair play and non-violence.
6. Treat another person's property with consideration and respect.
7. Respect the law and customs of each area they may visit in foreign countries.
